// Brief description of work series

Kathrin Sachse has developed a new style of photography that gives her art a unique selling point. By incorporating hand-worked steel, copper and brass into her abstract works, she breaks down the duplicability of photography to create unique pieces. All works - including the photography itself - are clearly defined individual pieces. The novelty of her art was recognized at the international art fair EuropArtFair 2023 in Amsterdam with the EuropArtAward 2023.

Form and color are the focus of the photographic compositions, which, under the guiding principle "The photographer as graphic artist", move on the border between painting and printmaking. With more than 40 solo and group exhibitions in Germany and abroad to date, as well as international art fairs, the artist, who was born in Leipzig in 1972, is a permanent fixture on the art scene.

Since 2023, she has been represented by the internationally renowned LDXArtodrome Gallery. As a regular artist at the gallery, new opportunities opened up in 2023, including participation in the LUCCA Artfair in Italy. She was also accepted into ARTPRICE, the world market leader for art information, in 2023. In the same year, she took part in the renowned EUROPARTFAIR2023 art fair for the first time as a self-represented artist. The additional representation by the New York-based gallery Artifact from 2023 opened up new opportunities with participation in art fairs in Miami, Los Angeles and New York.

As a member of the BBK München und Oberbayern, the Leipziger Jahresausstellung e.V. and the Kunstverein München, the committed artist is involved in a wide range of artistic and social activities.

Kathrin Sachse has consistently lent the genre of photography her own artistic expression, which defies any categorizing classification. With great authenticity, she creates an abstract space of reality that invites the viewer to engage in discourse. By objectifying her photographic art, Kathrin Sachse interweaves her impressions with her philosophy in the

truest sense of the word. Using the digital possibilities, the truth and authenticity of photography is preserved, which is always based on the existential and is never staged or arranged. The interplay of work and title forms a harmonious synthesis in the artist's complex thought synthesis.

Kathrin Sachse has been fascinated by the genre of photography since her earliest youth; the camera is her constant companion and source of new ideas and perspectives on life and people. Breaks in her life have repeatedly led Kathrin Sachse into border areas and driven her forward in her artistic development. After more than 30 years in the Rhine-Main region, where she has found a diverse field of tension for her abstract photographic art, she moved to the vicinity of Munich in 2023 and continues to develop her art in what is now her fourth cycle of works.

With her art, Kathrin Sachse conveys various dimensions of perspectives on the world and life in general. The philosophical and questioning aspect of her works is particularly evident in the sometimes unwieldy titles. In Kathrin Sachse's photographic expression, personal themes merge with her philosophy of life, creating new universes in which the viewer can penetrate into deeper areas of life. She paints a positive picture in the form of an abstract view of the imperfect, transient and imperfect. The motifs, which can only rarely be assigned to reality, nevertheless leave no doubt that they have already undergone various states of change. The photographs, whose compositions are reminiscent of graphics, succeed in making a positive start here with great intensity. They evoke the idea of assigning a new meaning to changes and thus marking a departure into new worlds.

The expressive power of her works is enhanced by the inclusion of other materials such as hand-worked steel, copper and brass as integral parts of her art. She processes all the materials herself, from welding the steel frames to coating the steel, copper or brass plates. At this point, she consistently breaks down the duplicability of photography metamorphically to create unique pieces.

Time-critical positions play an important role in the artist's work. This gives rise to the idea of mindfulness for everything that is. In her four work cycles to date, "Abstractions of Decay", "Interweavings of Impressiveness", "Asymmetry of the Elementary" and "Bending the Existential", Kathrin Sachse increasingly focuses her artistic view on the asymmetries in our contemporary world structure. The subject is never the obviously beautiful, but rather that which is usually only perceived through her photography and achieves an aesthetic in her pictures that leaves the viewer astonished.

For the artist, focusing on the seemingly dysfunctional and recognizing a value, a beauty, precisely there, is a step towards a more mindful society.
